

Andrea Maxfield is currently working on a biography of Joseph Smith under the direction of Richard E. Turley Jr. She was previously a historic sites curator in the Church History Department of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. As a curator, she worked on interpretation and messaging at historic sites in the western region of the United States. She has worked in the Church History Department for twenty-one years, and in the Church's Public Affairs Department for four years.

Andrea holds a master's degree in U.S. History from the University of Utah, with an emphasis in religious and women's histories. She was a co-recipient of the Helen Papanikolas Women's History Award from the Utah State Historical Society for her 2020 paper on female dynasties of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in the mid-nineteenth to early-twentieth centuries. She is married to Michael K. Maxfield, has four children and eleven grandchildren.
